

Study Abroad Photo Contest: 2013

Entries:

- The photo contest is available to all UD students who studied abroad (both short-term and for a semester) outside the United States from the fall semester of 2012 to the summer term of 2013.
- Students can submit up to two (2) photos for each category, meaning students can enter eight (8) photos total. The four categories can be seen below.
- All photos must be submitted electronically through the Study Abroad 101 Moodle page, indicating where the picture was taken and when you studied abroad in the submission information.
- Each picture submitted must represent each category respectively. The International Studies Office has the final decision whether a photo does or does not represent the category.
- Photos containing alcohol, questionable content, or other illegal activities will not be considered.
- By entering the contest you are giving the International Studies Office permission to use your photo(s) in various marketing activities, publications, and/or on the Web for the purpose of promoting study abroad at the University of Dubuque. This means all photos, not just winning entries, will be eligible for inclusion in such activities.
- You may begin uploading your photos on Monday, October 28th.
- Entries must be uploaded by Friday, November 8th at 11:30 PM. Photos uploaded after will not be considered.

Voting and Winners:

- All photo entries will be hung in the Bisignano Art Gallery in Heritage Center during International Education Week (November 11-15).
- Anyone in the UD community (students, faculty, staff, etc.) will be eligible to vote for their favorite photos once per day.
- Voting will take place during International Education Week from Monday, November 11th until Thursday, November 14th from 11:00 am until 1:00 pm.
- Voters will indicate their favorite photo from each category, and will also vote on their favorite overall photo. Therefore, there will be a winner of each category, and one overall winner.
- The winning photos will be revealed and displayed at the International Fair on Friday, November 15th.
