- *PRF 200 to meet Personal/Fin. Stewardship Gen. Ed.
- *HIST 211 / 212 to meet Hist./Phil./Politics Gen. Ed. and Education requirement

Admission to the program occurs during the same semester that EDU 200 is taken.

Admission Criteria

- 1. Completion of a C or better in ENG 101, ENG 104, MATH 112 (or higher), COM 101, EDU 100, EDU 200, EDU 202
- 2. GPA 2.75 or higher
- 3. Admissions Essay
- 4. Application
- 5. All grades must be C or better and students can only retake a class one time
- 6. Completion of 10 service learning hours in EDU 1007. Completion of 20 school-based hours in EDU 200
- 8. Completion of Admission Interview

Additional Teaching Endorsement can be added and will be discussed when assigned to an advisor in the Education Department
