- 2. Must earn a "C" or better in all PNRS requirements. No PNRS course may be repeated more than once. PNRS requirements include the first two years of classes, with the exception of WVS I, II and Gen. Ed. requirements listed below
- 3. Earn a PNRS science GPA of 3.00 or better. Courses include CHM 105, BIO 211, BIO 212 and BIO 314.
