



## Rotor Wing Flight Cost Estimates for 2020-2021

The Flight Center recently completed a review of the pilot ratings required to qualify for graduation. The expected cost in today's dollars to qualify for graduation is approximately \$145,700\*. Students and their families should allocate a minimum of \$36,425/year\* for flight training on a four-year flying program.

*\*The Certified Flight Instructor rating is not required to qualify for graduation but it is highly encouraged.*
