Other majors recommended courses:

- Education – GPA 2.75; ALL courses for education majors require grade of C or better; CAAP Test required; US History, Biology with lab, Intro to Literature
- Flight Operations – Precalculus (or higher-level math) or General Physics I and lab
- Nursing – GPA 3.0; ALL nursing prerequisites require grade of C or better and minimum 3.0 GPA in all 4 science courses; CNA, Composition I & II, Public Speaking, College Algebra, Statistics, Microbiology with lab, A & P I & II with labs, General/Organic/Biochemistry with lab (specific chemistry class for nursing), Nutrition, Intro to Psychology, Developmental Psychology, Intro to Sociology; labs for science courses must be in-person
